

RULES FOR SHOW

1. Entries shall be free. All exhibits must be benched before 6pm, Thursday, 4th August, 2011.
2. All plants must be **clearly labeled with labels in a prominent position** with the exhibitor's name on the back of the plant name label, for the benefit of the show marshal.
3. Any plant can only win one prize in the schedule. All plants are eligible for any special prizes.
4. This show is for growers, who are **current financial members** of the Manly Warringah Orchid Society Inc. and only they shall be eligible to enter.
5. An exhibitor may enter any number of entries in any class. Entries in joint names are acceptable.
6. All exhibits in competitive sections will have been **owned and personally grown by the exhibitor for 6 months prior to the show.**
7. Judging will be in accordance with the rules as set out by the Society in this schedule or in accordance with the standards of the Orchid Society of NSW Inc.
8. No award will be given if in the opinion of the judges it is not warranted. The Society may give other prizes.
9. No exhibitor shall have any claim against the Manly Warringah Orchid Society Inc., for any loss of, or damage to plants or miscellaneous items.
10. Exhibits must not be removed until completion of the show, 4pm Sunday, without the permission of the show marshal or deputy.
11. Classes 29,30,31,32 and 42 comprise species or hybrids from the Commonwealth of Australia and all its Territories, together with New Zealand, New Caledonia, Vanuatu, Fiji and Papua New Guinea including the Bismarck Archipelago, Solomon Islands and Iran Jaya.
12. The Committee reserves the right to add classes and vary rules where warranted.
13. Class 43 Miniature. For our purposes miniature has the following meaning – "An orchid having a maximum height (excluding raceme) of 150mm (6 inches) and a flower size not exceeding 12mm (1/2 inch)".
14. Classes 41,42,43 First flowering seedling Class includes any orchid raised from seed, includes hybrids and species. However, it specifically excludes 'mericlones' ie plants derived from meristem propagation.

FLORAL ART RULES

- * Wirework only in Class 1 & 2.
- * Other classes, orchids must predominate and other small flowers may be added.
- * Entries must be received by Thursday evening or Friday morning before 10am. Judging at 11am.
